AND NOW, this *1st* day of ~~February~~ *March*, 2010, Plaintiff's Motion to Produce a Corporate Designee is Granted.

The references to the issue of Adopting the Master's Recommendations is omitted as surplusage. The decision to grant this Motion is based on the Court's independent review of the relevant documents and the prior Orders of this Court. The permissible areas of inquiry are set forth below:

- The process by which it was determined that a permit was not required for the lagoon/landfill at the Ringwood facility;
- Discussions that were had regarding the need to have the lagoon/landfill permitted under the newly enacted Illinois Environmental Protection Act of 1972;
- The steps that were taken to determine whether or not the lagoon/landfill needed to be permitted pursuant to the Illinois Environmental Protection Act of 1972;
- Information that was given to the State with regard to the permitting of the lagoon/landfill in light of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act of 1972; and
- Why the lagoon/landfill never received a permit after the passing of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act of 1972.

The deposition shall be completed within twenty (20) days of the date of this Order.
